Dress Code

*Proper attire, including shirts and shoes, must be worn at all times on the golf course and in the clubhouse. Shirts without collars (except for women's golf shirts), tee-shirts, tank tops, short shorts, work denims or swimsuits are **NOT** allowed on the golf course or in the clubhouse. Dress denim jeans are permitted in the clubhouse but not the golf course. It is the responsibility of each member to instruct his/her guests of the dress code policy.*

We appreciate you taking pride in your Club and would remind everyone to continue to: repair ball marks; replace divots; keep carts 30 feet away from greens and tees; and knock bunker sand off your shoes before walking on the greens when playing.

Signing Purchase Tickets

Please assist the Grille Room, Halfway House, Beverage Cart and Golf Shop staffs by signing your sales ticket for each purchase. This helps confirm proper charges and eliminates questions on your monthly member statements. Additionally, as credit card laws have changed the past 18 months, we have been forced to follow suit. Since we are extending credit to members when you make a purchase, we must have verification of permission.

Turtle Cash Credit Book

The Club's Credit Book system is active for the 2011 season. Any prizes you earn from golf events this year are tracked on the Club's accounting system. This allows you to view your credit book balance on the Club's website in the Members Login-in section under "Credit Book". Credits may be used for purchases of Golf Shop Merchandise, cart fees and guest fees. You will no longer need to turn in your Turtle Cash certificates to redeem, you may simply request the Golf Shop staff to use your credit book balance on any purchase you make in the Golf Shop.

Yellow Ball Tourney

Saturday, May 14th, 10am Shotgun Start
ABCD Format
Ladies and Men's Division

TEAMS: All teams will be randomly picked by the Golf Shop staff. Each Team will have 4 players (ABCD Players). The A players will play from the Blue Tees and the B, C and D players will play from the White Tees. Players 70 and Older will play from the Black Tees.

TOURNAMENT FORMATS: There are 2 Tournaments going on in this Event.

- The Net Yellow Ball tourney, and the Two (2) Net Best Ball of the 4 tourney.

TOURNAMENT SCORING: There will be two separate scores for each team per hole. The NET score of the Yellow Ball is alone. The other score is 2 Net Best Balls of the 4, the Yellow Ball score can be used in the 2 Net Best Ball score but does not have to be used.

HOW TO PLAY: Each Team will choose a revolving order for play. Each team member will have 4 designated holes to use the Yellow Ball. Teams should choose their order of play by the handicap number on each hole to maximize each player's individual handicap to gain the most shots per player on his/her holes using the Yellow Ball.

Teams should choose a player, based on his/her handicap, to play the following holes:

Player 1	Holes 1, 5, 9, 13
Player 2	Holes 2, 6, 10, 14
Player 3	Holes 3, 7, 11, 15
Player 4	Holes 4, 8, 12, 16

(*Holes 17 & 18 can be played by any member of the team but that player cannot play both HOLES.)

The prize fund will be split with 60% to the Yellow Ball pool and 40% to the net ball pool.
